MEMORIAL APPLICATION AT ST EDMUND'S - There is a notice at the back of church, in the porch and on the noticeboard outside about an application for a new headstone, which is a replacement of an existing headstone, identical except for the addition of words marking another person who is now interred there. Please have a look and if you have any comments please direct them as indicated on the notice.
